(Read Philippians 2:1-11 as part of your discussion)

Read Luke Chapter 2. Look for the themes of beauty, simplicity and humility.

Food is such an important part of our Christmas celebrations. Think about LOAF when you buy

(Locally produced, Organically grown, Animal friendly, Fairly traded).
