
The question does **not** ask what job you hope to do

Time to reflect

Abraham and Sarah were an elderly couple who desperately hoped for a child. They kept their faith in God and were rewarded with a child, Isaac.

Joseph is one of the most prominent figures in the Bible. He is known for his incredible story of resilience, faith and hope. He still kept faith, even when things seemed desperate.

Despite facing a situation that seemed hopeless, **David** defeated the giant Goliath with just a stone and sling, showing the power of hope and faith in God.

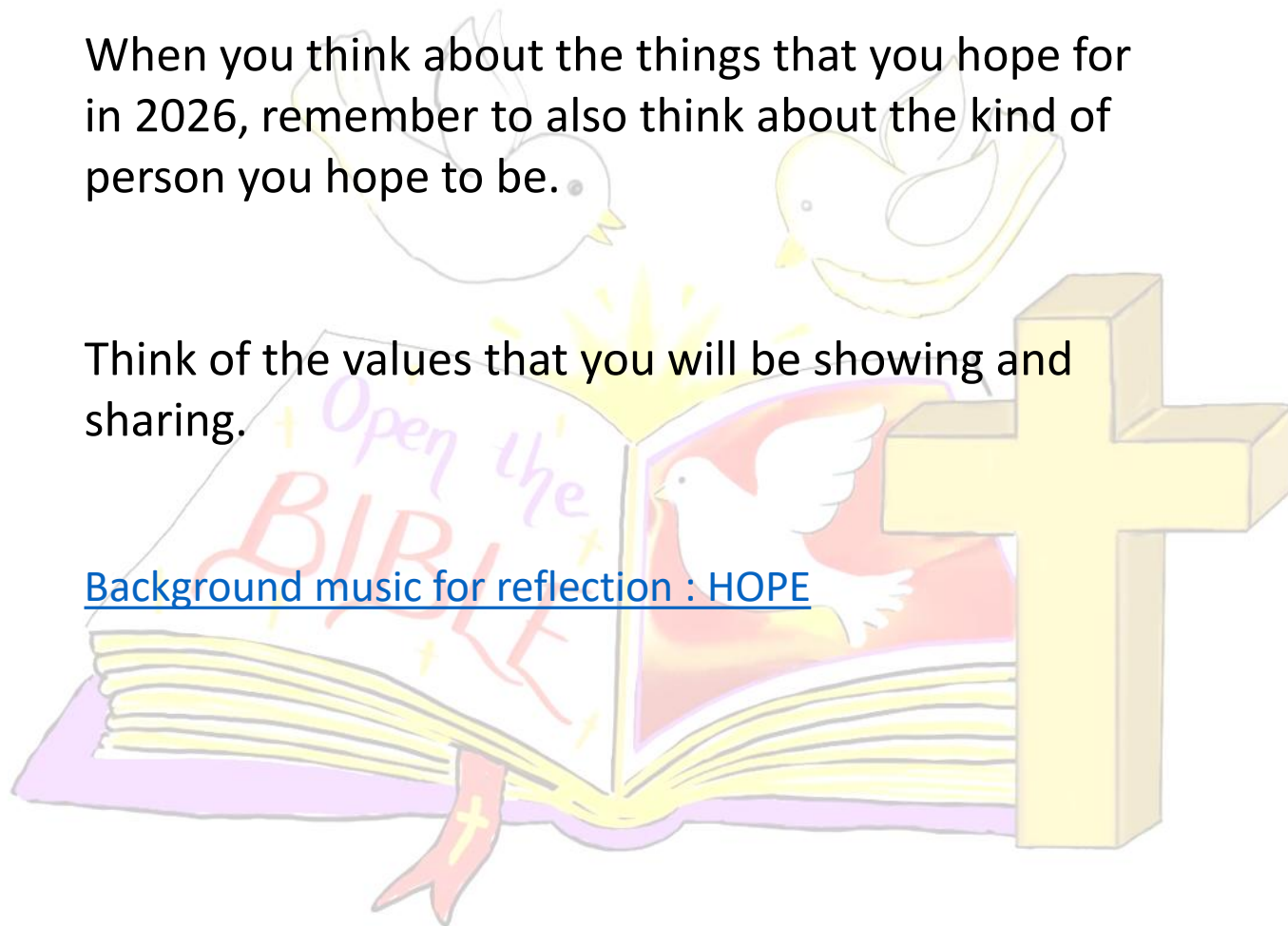


Time to reflect

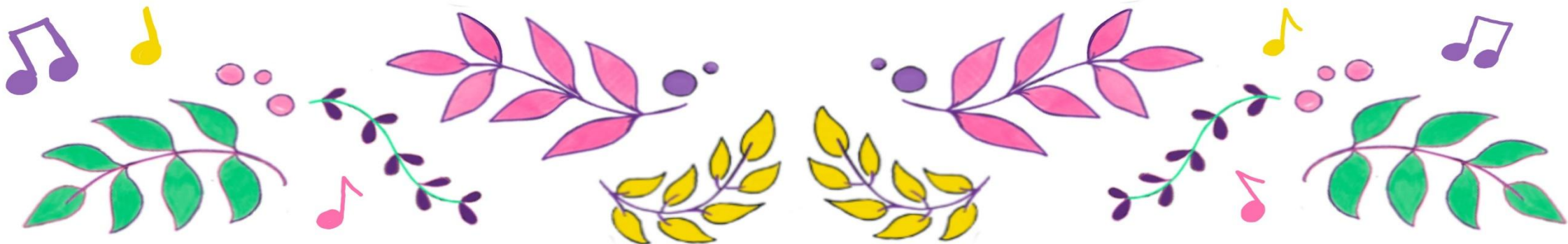

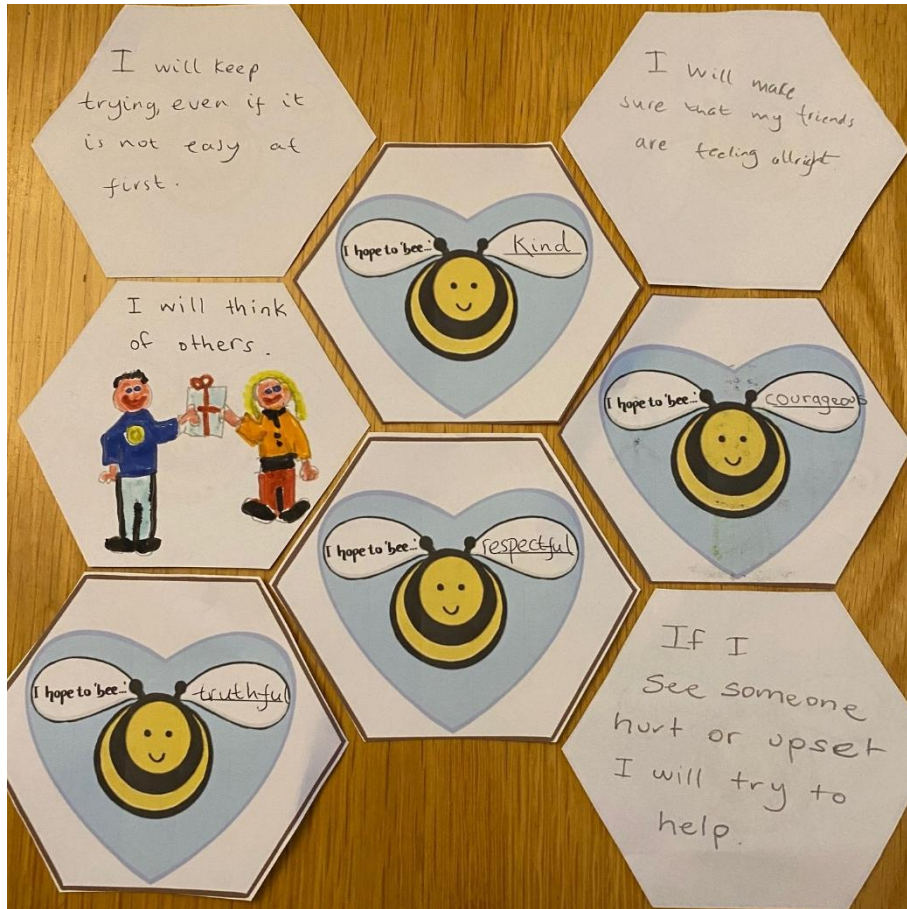

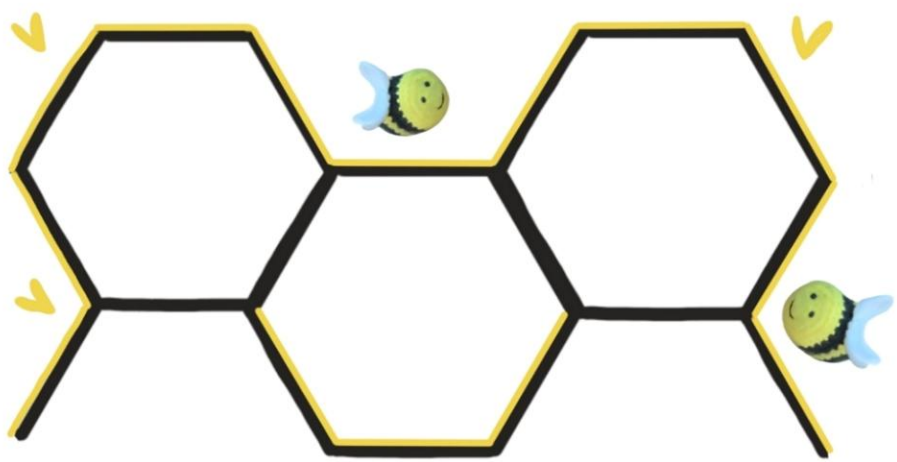
