What is the Living Faith programme?

Living Faith is the name of a set of study modules that are open to any Christian wanting to know more about their faith. They also form part of the training course for Licensed Lay Ministers in the Anglican Diocese of Peterborough, and for Methodists training for lay ministry in this District.

LF2— Reading the New Testament

Acquiring a deeper grasp of the New Testament

LF3— Reading the Old Testament

The Old Testament and its Christian importance

LF4— Introduction to Church History

Getting a handle on the history of the Church, and some key periods within it

LF5— Pastoral Care in Ministry & Mission

Meeting needs beyond the physical; approaches to pastoral care with a Christian tradition

LF6— Christian Doctrine : we believe

Comparing our experiences with Christians past and present, to explore the nature of God

LF7— Ethics

Finding a framework in which to respond to a variety of today's moral issues

LF8— The Mission of God

Understanding God's mission for us, and how we can be part of it

LF9— Worship and the Sacraments

Understanding how worship developed over time, to become the worship of today
