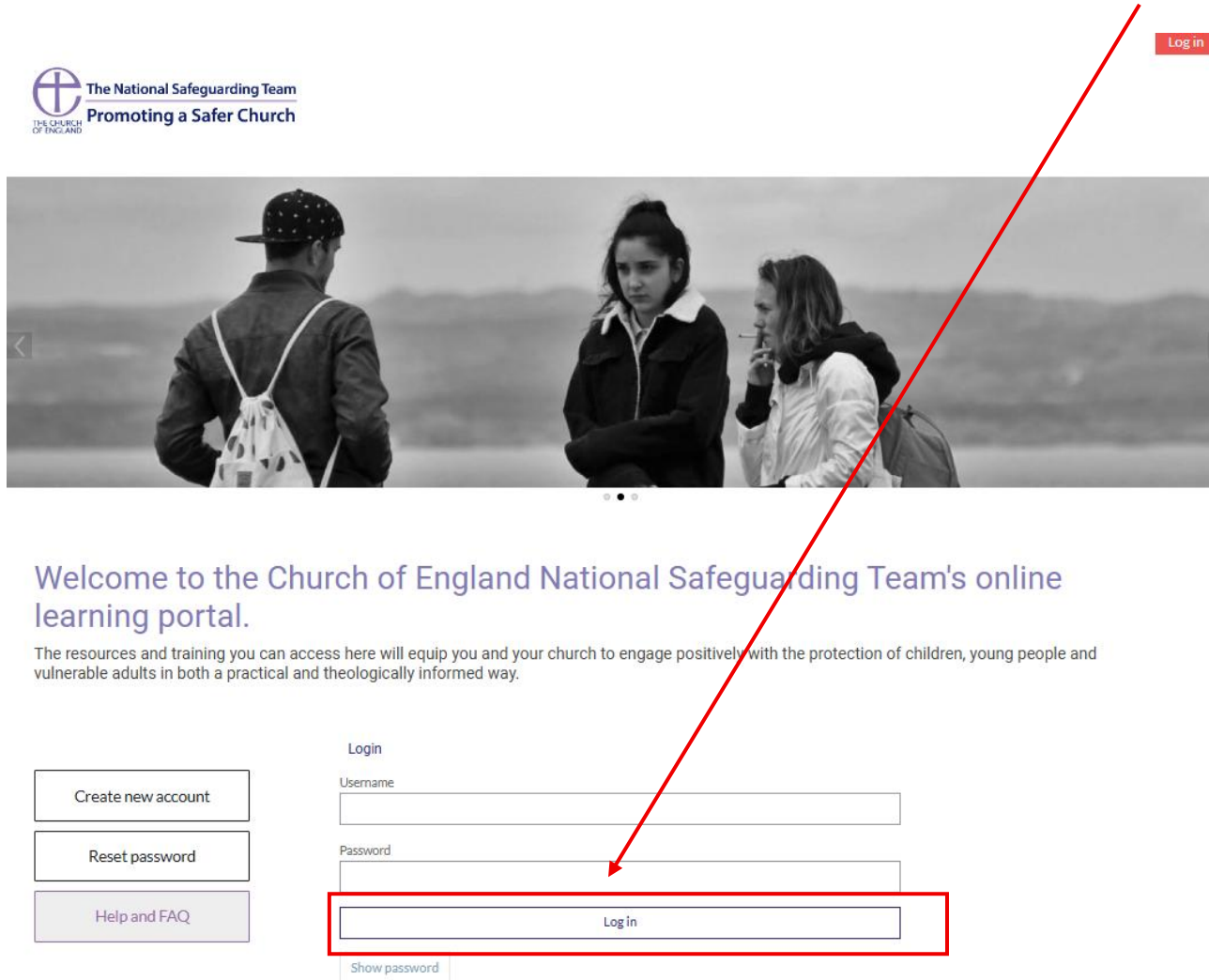


TO DO BASIC AWARENESS:
